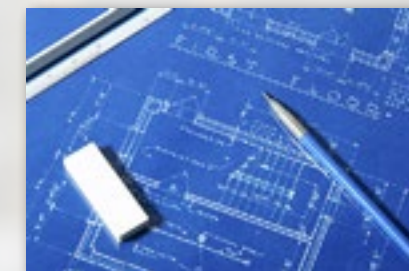
1. Partner with local women's or children's ministry to help fill a need.
